

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS – Econometric Career Days 2024**

Terms and conditions concerning participation in the Econometric Career Days 2024, organised by FAECTOR

### **A. General**

1. FAECTOR has the right to cancel the event at any time due to any circumstances beyond its control and without any possible compensation for the participants or anyone else.
2. FAECTOR cannot be held responsible for any damages and injuries that occur during the event.

### **B. Participation**

1. Participation at the Econometric Career Days 2024 is only possible for students who are a member of FAECTOR, with the exception of the ECD Talks which is open for all students of Erasmus University.
2. Selection for the activities of the Econometric Career Days will be done by FAECTOR. For some events, this will be based on an uploaded CV.
3. Selection for the informal events, and interviews will be done by the participating companies based on the uploaded CV.
4. There is no opportunity to discuss and criticise the selection procedure or selection.
5. By subscribing for an event organised by FAECTOR, you accept the terms and conditions. No controversy will be taken into consideration.

### **C. Obligations participants**

1. If you cancel your participation at an event of the Econometric Career Days 2024 without any valid reason less than 5 working days before the event, if you do not show up at the event without informing us, or if you leave the session before the end, you will be placed on the blacklist.
2. If you do not show up unannounced or without a valid reason, or if you leave the session before the end, we will give your name and personal details to the company who was hosting the online event.
3. Inappropriate behaviour gives the organisation the power to exclude the student from further participation and to place the student on the blacklist.
4. Starting from ECD 2024, a fine policy for late cancellations and no-shows will be enforced. To compensate for the damage suffered by Econometric Career Days (such as rented rooms, purchased materials, reputational damage, etc.) and to give everyone a fair chance to participate in popular activities, we have implemented a fine policy. The fine policy is standard and no discussion is possible.
5. The fine amount varies by event and the time of the cancellation. Cancellations must be made before 5:00 PM; otherwise, the fine for the following working day will apply. The fine increases as the event approaches. You can find the specific fine amounts per event and the timing of the cancellation in the table below:

#### D. Blacklist

1. Students who are put on the blacklist will be put at the bottom of the waiting list of any career event which is organised by FAECTOR for 2 months.
2. There is no opportunity to discuss the blacklist.
3. The blacklist is only available for the board of FAECTOR and will not be published.

#### E. Privacy

1. The user agrees that FAECTOR is allowed to use all information that is uploaded to the website for personal use. By uploading a CV the user accepts that this information may be distributed to the participating companies for selection purposes. In case you have questions about your privacy, please contact FAECTOR for more information.
2. FAECTOR stores your personal data in compliance with the GDPR. Data is not stored for longer than is strictly necessary in order to realise the objectives for which data are gathered.
